

DECLARATION OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE  
CEATS MINISTERS OF TRANSPORT

Luxembourg, 22 April, 2005

The Ministers welcomed the 5<sup>th</sup> Ratification by Bosnia Herzegovina and were encouraged by the entry into force of the CEATS Agreement.

The Ministers were encouraged by the completion of the definition phase.

The Ministers welcomed the declaration of the European Commission to the effect that the CEATS project constituted a fundamental step towards the realisation of the Single European Sky.

The Ministers agreed to move forward without delay with the implementation of the CEATS project and reiterated their invitation to the three remaining States to ratify the CEATS Agreement.

The Ministers recognized the progress to be made on:

- Regulation in the CEATS Area and the Single European Sky
- CEATS Institutional Arrangements
- Implementation of the CEATS UAC
- Civil/Military Matters
- CEATS Social Forum
- Decision-making process

constituted a fundamental element of the successful implementation of the project, and therefore set up a high-level group of representatives of the Ministers and Eurocontrol, tasked with making a proposal to the Ministers at a Ministerial Conference to be organized in four weeks' time.


