<u>Title</u>: ATS Common Data Link Services (ACDLS)

<u>General:</u> This Call for Tenders covers the ATS Common Datalink Service (ACDLS), with a view to select the future Datalink Service Provider.

Technical subject matter:

The ATS common datalink services (ACDLS) governance has been established by means of the conclusion of the ACDLS Memorandum of Cooperation (ACDLS governance MoC), dated 1 October 2021, the purpose of which is to establish an ACDLS governance including its bodies, policies and processes by means of cooperation between the Parties to jointly improve and promote the development of a common approach, vision, design, procurement, management and evolution of ATS common datalink services. On 1st March 2023, the 18 ACDLS Governance members signed a common procurement agreement (CPA) and mandated EUROCONTROL for the procurement of European ACDLS to be rendered by the DSP and the management of the Contract(s) in accordance with the provisions of the CPA. The ACDLS governance is now counting 25 members.

EUROCONTROL has 41 Member States and two Comprehensive Agreement States and is a civil-military intergovernmental organisation committed to building, together with its partners, a Single European Sky, i.e. arrangements allowing the air navigation management system in Europe to achieve the level of performance required for the coming decades. The EUROCONTROL Agency, which was set up to carry out the Organisation's mission, provides sustained support for all its Member States, for the European Commission and for the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA). This assistance is provided in numerous fields, in particular those of regulation, general oversight of air navigation management arrangements, and the environment. The EUROCONTROL Agency is also tasked with the permanent monitoring of the performance of the air navigation management system in place in Europe and of the associated civil-military coordination. CTR.FTS.VDLM2.070

The Contractor shall provide the ATN/OSI VDLm2 service to all equipped aircraft in the ACDLS service area contracted including non-AOC Airspace users without any need for the airspace users to make any technical or administrative change.

CTR.FTS.LACS.020

The Contractor shall implement deploy and operate a central ADS-C service by implementing the requirements described in the section 4 of the EUROCONTROL Common Service Specification [S18].

CTR.SOW.REG.010

The Contractor shall be continuously certified as from the Effective Service Date as an ATM/ANS-CNS provider against the applicable EU regulatory framework including (EC) IR 2017/373 [IR373] and its upcoming amendments and shall provide ACDLS services as a certified entity.

TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT CRITERIA - mandatory Tenderer Requirements

TDR.SOW.PPM.020

The Tenderer shall deliver a draft ACDLS Design Document (ADD – CDRL 020) covering the design of all DSP Services and infrastructure including sub-contracted elements intended to be provided to DSP Users.
