## MEMBERSHIP

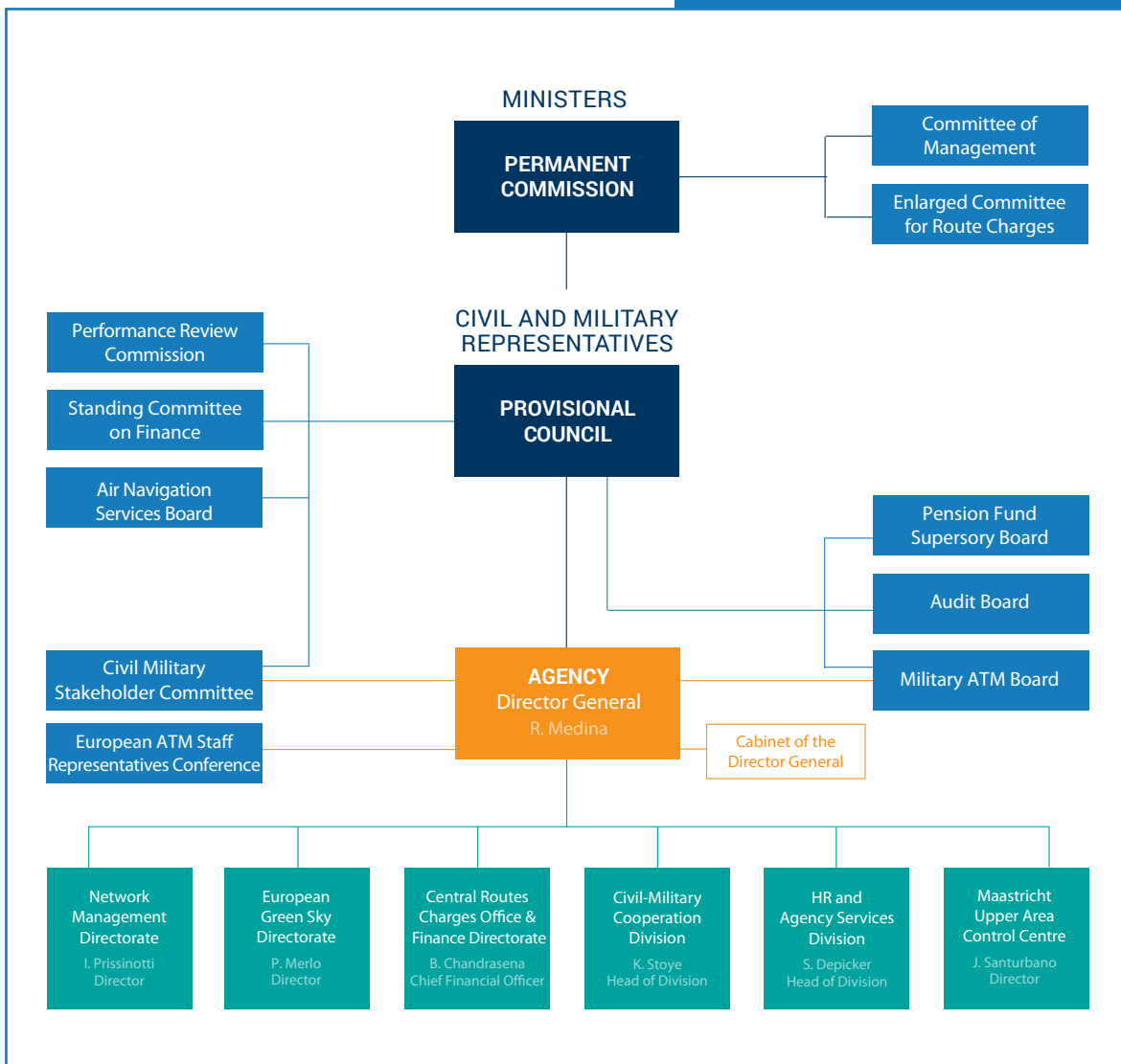
EUROCONTROL is an intergovernmental organisation with 41 Member States, 2 Comprehensive Agreement States and 1 Transitional Agreement State, set to become EUROCONTROL's 42nd Member State on 1 January 2025. The European Community signed an Accession Protocol in 2002. Our Member States include all of the EU States.

# PARTNERSHIP

EUROCONTROL is an intergovernmental organisation, driven by its Member States (civil and military authorities). However, it also aims to ensure that the interests of all aviation stakeholders are represented in its decision-making process.

Consequently, airspace users, air navigation service providers and airports are fully involved in helping the Agency support European aviation.

## EUROCONTROL Agency Structure



To better serve European aviation, EUROCONTROL has organised its activities around six functions:

## Network Management Directorate (NMD)

In its role as the SES Network Manager, NMD coordinates network management functions relating both to network planning (airspace design) and operations (ATFCM, AIM) and also to the coordinated pan-European deployment of operational and technical improvements, including those related to SESAR. NMD provides support to airport activities, coordinates safety actions and manages frequencies and scarce resources. It also delivers support services to air navigation service providers and FABs; and finally monitors the network management contribution to the performance targets of the SES.

Through its Aviation Learning Centre in Luxembourg, NMD provides state-of-the-art multi-channel learning services for ATM staff, regulators, airlines, flow management operators and aviation professionals.

## European Green Sky Directorate (EGSD)

EGSD brings under one roof technology, innovation, international cooperation, sustainability and aviation intelligence.

It leads and coordinates the evolution of European ATM and supports EUROCONTROL's strategic positioning within the European aviation landscape by fostering the pan-European implementation of the Single Sky and its related policies.

Through the Innovation Hub in Brétigny, it manages the Agency R&D and innovation activities and contributes to EU ATM research, initiating, promoting and managing pan-European R&D and industrialisation programmes. EGSD also ensures that the Agency ATM research effort is aligned to the SESAR programme.

It leverages Agency's data resources to develop aviation intelligence and manages the Agency activities in support of aviation sustainability, climate change and related policies.

EGSD ensures the provision of efficient support to the Performance Review Commission through the Aviation Intelligence Unit, ensures efficient partnership and support to key aviation partners and industry associations through cooperation agreements.

## Civil-Military Cooperation Division (CMC)

CMC provides the appropriate military-military and civil-military ATM coordination across the Agency and is also responsible for overseeing the Agency ATM Policy and Strategy. It engages and maintains high-level relations with key European and international aviation partners, in particular with the national military, NATO and relevant EU entities. It is the focal point for military and civil-military cooperation and coordination on all relevant Agency's activities.

Furthermore, CMC supports the EUROCONTROL Member States and ANSPs on military and civil-military cooperation matters.

## Central Route Charges Office & Finance Directorate (CRCO & CF)

CF's CRCO operates, maintains and develops the Multilateral Route Charges System on behalf of the Member States. In addition, the CRCO operates 19 bilateral agreements for the collection of terminal/communication charges or air navigation charges (of which 4 are agreements with non-Member States). In all, the CRCO collects charges on behalf of 43 States.

CF provides financial management services to the Agency including business planning, quality and compliance, and management of the Pension Fund.

## Maastricht Upper Area Control Centre (MUAC)

MUAC provides air traffic services to defined standards of safety and performance levels in the upper airspace of Belgium, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and the north-west of Germany. MUAC also provides its operational and technical know-how to other parts of the Agency for the development and deployment of SESAR. MUAC supports the participating States in establishing the Functional Airspace Block Europe Central (FABEC).

## Human Resources and Agency Services (HRS)

HRS deals with the Agency's human resources, finance, planning and logistical needs, as well as supporting staff and pensioners on operational HR and finance matters.

HRS supports the business by providing efficient and modern HR processes that boost productivity and motivation.

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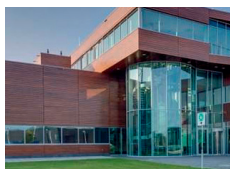
