

## TERMINAL CHARGES IN CROATIA (Ref. LD 2022/10)

### Adjusted unit rates applicable to September 2022 flights

**Effective from 1 SEPTEMBER 2022**

1. The EUROCONTROL Organisation is entrusted with the billing and collection of terminal charges on behalf of Croatia Control Ltd (CCL).
2. The terminal charges are levied for each flight departing from the Airports Zagreb (LDZA), Zagreb Lucko (LDZL), Split (LDSP), Dubrovnik (LDDU), Zadar (LDZD), Pula (LDPL), Rijeka (LDRI), Brać (LDSB), Mali Lošinj (LDLO) and Osijek (LDOS) and are split in two charging zones.
3. The adjusted unit rates of charge applicable from 1 September 2022:

In accordance with the Rules governing the terminal charges in Croatia (Information Circular LD 2022/01), the adjusted unit rates have been calculated by using the average exchange rate of 1 EUR=7.51052 HRK for the month of August 2022 (monthly average of the "Closing Cross Rates" calculated by Reuters based on daily BID rate).
