DIRECTIVE No. 17/98

relating to the conclusion by the Agency of training agreements with public or private entities of non-Member States and of international Organisations

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation of 13 December 1960 as amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 6.1(b), 7.3 and 13 thereof;

Having regard to the tasks of the Organisation set out in Article 2.1, of the revised Convention, as early implemented by Decision N°71 of the Permanent Commission of 9 December 1997, in particular its paragraph (o);

Having regard to Directive No.12/80 of the Permanent Commission of 10 May 2012 relating to the implementation of the User Pays Principle;

Whereas those training agreements pertain to unique training courses and services that cannot be provided by any other training organisations in EUROCONTROL Member States;

Whereas it is understood that, in providing such training, EUROCONTROL will ensure that it will not be in competition with its Member States' ANSPs or with their own activities in the domain of training courses;

On the proposal of the Director General and Provisional Council;

GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE:

Sole Article

The Agency may conclude, on the Organisation's behalf, training agreements with public or private entities of non-Member States and of international organisations subject to the application of the Users Pay Principle.
