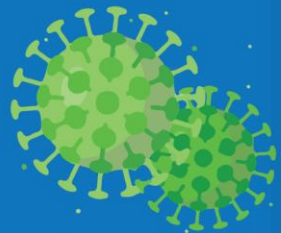

EASA AHSP Monitoring and Support Activities

1. AHSP will deliver only if implemented by all stakeholders - regulators and industry - and as a common set of collaboratively applied measures
2. Current situation
 - Different degrees of the implementation of the Guidelines in Member States
 - Various regulatory approaches & different aviation health safety requirements on State level
 - Differing practices among various industry players
3. Conclusion: need to reinforce alignment and monitoring of the implementation of the measures to secure public confidence
4. EASA collaborates with and is committed to support:
 - Competent national authorities through AHSP Monitoring Group
 - Aviation industry through EASA AHSP Monitoring/Aviation Industry Charter Programme & cooperation with industry associations (ACI Europe, IATA, A4E, EBAA & ERA)

EASA COVID-19 Aviation Industry Charter

1. Charter signatories: 39 airport operators and 30 airlines doing business in the EU Member States, Albania, Egypt, Georgia, North Macedonia, Norway, Montenegro, Singapore, Tunisia, Turkey and the UK

2. Weekly reporting (pre-defined KPIs + qualitative feedback) started on 6 July 2020; EASA is preparing a monthly overview of trends
3. First feedback indicates:
 - The Program captures around 30% of weekly traffic (reference: ACI Europe data)
 - Relative to the total passenger numbers, the number of cases of suspected or symptomatic passengers handled on the ground or in-flight remains low;
 - Main challenges include: passengers' non-adherence to the requirement to wear a face mask & enforcing medical face masks, social distancing at airports as the number of passengers increases, waiting times at airports (boarding, baggage claim) tend to rise beyond 15 minutes, queuing in border control areas.
 - Screening of passengers at airports is becoming more common and effective.
