- Resilience is not reliability++ (via more testing and/or redundancy)
- It is about making it possible to adapt to unforeseen situations
- This means (among other things) designing software services to be operated, not just "delivered"
- Closer collaboration between developers and end-users is "table stakes"

- "Complete" testing of software is not possible.
- How quickly/easily/fluidly software's behavior can be changed is critical to adapting to surprising disturbances
- Deployment of changes (bug fixes, new features, etc.) do not have to be "all or nothing"
