<p><u>Working experience</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- A minimum of 5 years relevant professional experience in the IT communications domain- Experience and in-depth knowledge of current IT-network technologies: IPv4/IPv6, MPLS, BGP, DSCP, NAT, DNS- Experience at project management level, contact with customers and/or providers- Experience and knowledge in security devices (firewall, IDS/IPS) and other network-related appliances (e.g. packet shapers, encryption/compression, etc)- WAN infrastructure (internet access, MPLS, DC-interconnection, cloud interconnection)- Experience in Software defined networking technologies (SD-WAN, SDN...)

E.g. production of meeting minutes, drafting of technical notes, etc - Capability to participate effectively in international working groups - Good interpersonal skills, ability to establish and maintain good professional relationships both internal and external - Ability to work under pressure and set clear priorities
