

PRIVACY STATEMENT ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

Aviation4Girls Event

EUROCONTROL protects your personal data in accordance with the EUROCONTROL Regulation on Personal Data Protection adopted by its Member States and published in 2008, and its Implementing Rules which were published in 2017.

1. What is Aviation4Girls? Why do we collect, store and process your data?

The initiative came from a group of eight women who originally started working together through Woman in Aviation International – European Network Chapter. After three years of great collaboration, the group, supported by its members, made the decision to evolve towards a new approach with the goal to encourage, empower, and educate all those with interests, lives, and work linked to aviation/aerospace without regard to race, ethnicity, gender identity, age, sexual orientation, physical or mental abilities, or point of view.

The theme of the event which EUROCONTROL is hosting on 13 October 2022 is “*The New Now - You are the Future of Aviation*”. The event itself will feature educational activities for around 100+ girls and boys aged 15 to 18. Participants will hear inspiring stories from female role models from different areas of aviation. They will also be able to watch career videos and participate in hands-on activities such as a virtual tour in a flight simulator and talk to experts who will help them to understand how to transform a passion into a job. In parallel, there will be a small career fair to learn what type of professions and careers are available to them.

We collect and use personal information about individuals directly when they register for events and programmes. The data are collected for organisational purposes (registration and access to the event, security, catering, etc.) and for advertising purposes.

2. What data do we collect, store and process about you?

We only collect personal data that we genuinely need. These are the data we collect:

- Contact details such as name, country of residence and email address
- Date of birth
- Dietary restrictions
- Name of your parent or guardian (if you are under 18)
- Nationality
- Photographs and recordings

We use photographs and recordings to promote Aviation4Girls and the work that we do. This might be to advertise our programmes and events, and to support our campaigning and advocacy work. We take photographs and recordings of people attending our programmes and meetings. We always obtain permission from the individual to take and use their image and explain how we intend to use it. Our legal basis for using personal information for this purpose is consent. We do not intend to collect data from minors, unless they have parental or guardian permission. However, we cannot check the age of the person filling the registration form online. We therefore advise parents to be involved in the online activities of their children in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. If you are convinced that we have collected personal information about a minor without this permission, please contact us by email (A4G@eurocontrol.int) and we will delete this information.

3. Who is your data disclosed to? Who has access to your data?

Access to your personal data is provided to EUROCONTROL staff and contractors responsible for the organisation of this event according to the “need to know” principle. We will only use your personal information for the purpose which it was provided to us and in ways that you would reasonably expect.

4. How long is your data kept?

Your personal information will be deleted after the event. As regards photos, once a parent or guardian grants permission for pictures to be taken of their child at the event, pictures may be posted on the EUROCONTROL and AviaALL public websites as well as on the organisations’ social media platforms. These photos will be kept for a year at least on our public websites.

5. What are your rights under the EUROCONTROL Data Protection Regulation?

You have the right to access, rectify, complete and update your data option by contacting us by email (web_helpdesk@eurocontrol.int). You have the right to object to the use of your personal data in some circumstances. You may also delete your personal information. You have the right to request additional information about the handling of your personal data by contacting by email (web_helpdesk@eurocontrol.int)

6. How can you withdraw consent you have given to EUROCONTROL?

You may withdraw your consent in any moment by contacting us by email (A4G@eurocontrol.int) we have received notification that you have withdrawn your consent, we will no longer process your information for the purpose or purposes you originally agreed to.

7. What do we do to avoid misuse or unauthorised access to data concerning you?

EUROCONTROL is committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure EUROCONTROL has put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information collected from you

8. What safeguards do we apply when we transfer your data to third parties?

We will not, under any circumstances, share with or sell your personal information to any third party for marketing purposes, and you will not receive offers from other companies.

9. Who can you contact if you have questions or want to make a complaint?
