Title: Tasking contract for Future CTM Activities

General: EUROCONTROL* is an intergovernmental organisation with 41 Member and 2 Comprehensive Agreement States. We are committed to building, together with our partners, a Single European Sky that will deliver the air traffic management (ATM) performance required for the twenty-first century and beyond.

Technical subject matter:

The present request is to publish a Call for Tender for the continuation of the CTM activities and tasks linked to the implementation of NSP objectives, the application of High Level Network CONOPS 2029 requirements and the 4 main pillars of activity, namely:

- Support to iNM
- Support for the implementation of CP1 requirements
- Contribution to the Operational Excellence Programme
- Contribution to the SESAR 3 activities.

The CTM team current effort is limited and cannot cover all the activities and deliverables required for the fulfilment of the activities and tasks.

The Contractor Team should comprise at least 3 (three) contractors. They will interact with the CTM Team of 3 (three) EUROCONTROL experts. The entire CTM activity is led by 1 (one) of the 3 (three) EUROCONTROL experts.

The contractors will interact also with other divisions, units and services from the EUROCONTROL Network Manager, as well as EUROCONTROL experts from other EUROCONTROL directorates, especially for the SESAR activities.

The duration of the contract is for 3 years plus 1 year optional.
