Three areas of concern for communities:

- 1. Increase in flight numbers
- 2. More concentrated flight paths
- 3. When change takes place

Solutions (1)

The solutions most likely to last are those which work for communities, airports and airlines

That requires on-going engagement with communities, allowing them to be partners in shaping any solutions.

Solutions (2)

- **Respite** to provide a break from the noise
- A cap (limit) on the number of aircraft permitted over a particular community
- Aircraft as high as possible for as long as possible
- Generous mitigation and compensation
- Limit night flights
