- Directives of the Permanent Commission -

Directive No. 23/113

relating to the extension of the current and future contractual relations necessary for the Pan-European Network Services (PENS) to public and private entities of non-Member States and of international organisations.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation of 13 December 1960, as amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 6.1 (b), 7.3 and 13 thereof;

Having regard to Article 2.1 of the revised Convention, as implemented early by Decision No. 71 of the Permanent Commission of 9 December 1997;

Having regard to Directive N° 15/88 of the Permanent Commission of 21 May 2015 which authorised the Director General to conclude the Contractual relations necessary for the New Pan-European Network Services (NewPENS) on behalf of the Air Navigation Service Providers and other Parties interested to use the NewPENS from the EUROCONTROL Member States and other States within the ICAO EUR/NAT Region and bordering States;

Having regard to Article 21 of the Contract Regulations of EUROCONTROL relating to Common Procurement;

Whereas on the basis of Directive N° 15/88 of the Permanent Commission of 21 May 2015 a Common Procurement Agreement (CPA) was concluded by the Director General on 31 December 2015 for the common procurement of the New Pan-European Network Services (NewPENS);

Whereas the New Pan-European Network Services (NewPENS) is also referred to as Pan-European Network Services (PENS);

Whereas PENS is a key enabler to the EATM Network and contributes to economies of scale and improving global interoperability;

Whereas the PENS Governance, composed of representatives of the PENS users, requested to extend PENS beyond its current geographical scope;

At the proposal of the Director General and the Provisional Council;

GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

Sole Article

The Director General shall be authorised, on behalf of the Organisation and upon request of the PENS Governance, to extend the current and future contractual relations necessary for

the common procurement of the Pan-European Network Services (PENS) to private or public entities of non-Member States and of international organisations
