Title: Mission Trajectory Concept Evolution (Study)

General: Enhancing civil-military cooperation and interoperability is at the core of EUROCONTROL objectives to ensure reaching the ATM performance ambitions, while granting effectiveness to military mission in the future European ATM environment as developed within SES and SESAR.

The CMC Division performs the civil-military cooperation function of EUROCONTROL by providing support to current ATM operations and coordinating projects for the development and implementation of concepts and systems supporting effective civil-military cooperation in future operations. In doing so, it is imperative to engage stakeholders effectively, securing their support to ensure the successful execution of its tasks.

The concept of operations for the future European ATM is Trajectory-Based Operations (TBO). Mission Trajectory (MT) is the overarching concept to civil-military collaborative processes for an integrated management of military demand for trajectories and airspace, throughout all ATM phases, from local to network levels. The key enabler to effective and harmonised management of MT data across ECAC States is the iOAT FPL mechanism.

The current MT concept document was published by EUROCONTROL in 2012. Since its publication, the concept has undergone significant developments across both operational and technical domains, brought forth by projects from either SESAR or EUROCONTROL. Furthermore, there are ongoing research, validation, and implementation projects expected to deliver mature updates to the concept.

Nevertheless, the evolution of military training, exercises and operations, driven by new assets and weapon systems are significantly impacting the operational requirements and operating methods associated to the MT concept. Within the above-described context, to meet actual and future requirements for the MT concept, the CMC Division of EUROCONTROL is launching this call for tenders to acquire expert level support to run a short-term (one year) study for delivering an updated concept document.

Technical subject matter: The tasks consist of providing an updated MT concept document. The expected outcome is a concept paper that reflects to date state-of-the-art developments, while providing directions to meeting future requirements, from a short, medium, and long-term perspectives. The relevance of the final study product depends on obtaining acceptance from the military stakeholder and securing support from other affected

stakeholders. The execution of the study shall adhere to an iterative approach, characterised by systematically planned activities leading to the production of both types of interim and final deliverables, subject to review and refinement.
