Dear Member States and Stakeholders,

I have the pleasure to submit to you draft edition 1.0 of the “EUROCONTROL Specification for Airport Collaborative Decision Making”.

Airport Collaborative Decision Making (A-CDM) is regarded as an important enabler that will improve operational efficiency, predictability and punctuality of the ATM network and among airport partners. This Specification describes the requirements of A-CDM to support its implementation at an airport and contributes to the implementation of the essential requirements of the EASA Basic Regulation and enables the implementation of the essential requirements of the CP1 Regulation 2021/116.

A-CDM focuses especially on aircraft turn-round and pre-departure processes. By linking the inbound flight with the outbound flight in the Airport CDM System the process tracks the progress of the outbound flight using a continuous sequence of significant events, known as milestones. These milestones are triggers for updating downstream estimates, issuing alert messages and notifications, etc. This process enables a CDM Airport to provide accurate estimates of take-off time to the Network Manager.

This new specification is now being submitted for formal consultation using the EUROCONTROL Standards Development Process, enabling all states and stakeholders to express their formal views. The responses and comments will be compiled, reviewed and taken into account in the preparation of the formal release. As such, I would strongly encourage you to respond.
