The Project Manager and Supervisor(s) of the Tenderer (Contractor <b>and</b> subcontractors) shall be at least VCA-VOL (Safety for Operational Super-visors VCA) certified.
The work force of Contractor and subcontractors assigned to the execution of this contract shall be at least B-VCA (Basic safety) certified.
The (sub)-Contractor shall be Legrand certified installation partner.
The (sub)-Contractor shall be Leviton certified installation partner.
The Tenderer shall have a CAR-insurance cover for the complete work.

Completeness, safety and well thought out plan (based upon open calculation without prices) in relation with the installation activities and protection of the existing active electrical- and data installations and CCC's in the MCR.
Completeness of the offer in relation to the installation of data cabling trays.
Completeness of the offer in relation to the data cabling works, and completeness of planned data cabling measurement procedures and tests.

**The economically most advantageous offer will be established in accordance with the following Award criteria:**

For the Technical tender, a weighting of 60% is applied, for the Financial tender, a weighting of 40%.
