<b><u>Title:</u></b>	Evolution of the EUROCONTROL aviation data mobile application phase II

### **General:**

The development of a EUROCONTROL aviation data mobile application (“the App”) is part of the ‘Aviation Intelligence +’ strategy which, in turn, is an integral part of Strategic Initiative III (‘Efficiently deliver the Agency’s key strategic projects and initiatives, maintaining its pan-European and unique civil-military role, and prioritising activities and resources to provide services to Member States and stakeholders within the established financial boundaries’) of EUROCONTROL’s Trajectory 2030 Strategy.

The purpose of the App is to share aviation data relevant for stakeholders in a timely manner, supporting decision-makers in their day-to-day job, and reinforcing the position of EUROCONTROL as the central, authoritative provider of European Aviation reference data.

### **Technical subject matter:**

The scope of the contract to be let following the present Call for Tender is:

- the incremental development of subsequent versions of the App and the associated web application in line with the requirements set forth in the next section, and
- the provision of technical support for the maintenance and continuity of service of the live versions of the App and web application throughout the duration of this contract.

The objective of this CFT is to select a supplier for the further development and maintenance of the app for a total duration of 18 months.

**Main selection and assessment criteria:**

TECHNICAL ASSESSMENT CRITERIA
<b>Mandatory requirements (PASS/FAIL criteria)</b>
The Tenderer shall have and provide in the technical tender a certificate attesting they comply with international quality standard ISO 9001 and/or European quality standard EN 29001.
Minimum 5 years of proven experience of the company in web design, development and management.
Minimum 10 years experience of the company in software requirements and their verification.
Minimum 5 years experience of the company in the management of aviation data or in the development of aviation data products.
Minimum 5 years experience of the company in development in React and React Native technologies.
Minimum 5 years experience of the company in mobile App design, development publication and management.
Minimum 5 years experience of the company in working with/for aviation stakeholders (e.g. EUROCONTROL or other aviation international organisations, ANSPs, airports, aircraft operators, etc.)
At least 3 years of relevant to the tasks professional experience for at least one members of the project execution team.
For the Project Manager/Team Leader, at least 5 years of relevant to the tasks experience.
The Project Manager/Team Leader shall possess a minimum English language proficiency level of B2 (CEFR) or equivalent.
<b>Mandatory requirements (SCORING criteria)</b>
Quality of the tender in its: a) overall understanding of the technical requirements and customer's needs, b) completeness of the project management plan.
Compliance with the technical requirements and quality of the proposed approaches to implement them.

**The economically most advantageous offer will be established in accordance with the following Award criteria:**

For the Technical tender, a weighting of 50% is applied, for the Financial tender, a weighting of 50%. Contracts will be awarded separately for each lot.
