



TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE MILITARY HARMONISATION GROUP (MilHaG)

Mission

According to Military ATM Board (MAB), MilHaG mission is to define, develop and promote harmonised pan-European military positions on Air Traffic Management and Communications Navigation & Surveillance (ATM/CNS) matters in order to improve co-ordination within the military community for the benefit of the whole ATM community taking into consideration already approved plans and strategies.

Tasks

1. To analyse the interaction between ATM/CNS and European military activities.
2. To identify the military needs with regard to particular ATM/CNS matters in order to ensure the operational capabilities.
3. To define harmonised requirements for the European ATM system which will enable the military to maintain the operational needs defined in Task 2 in the peacetime environment.
4. To develop common solutions.
5. To promote the harmonised military positions to the MAB and to the appropriate bodies as so deemed necessary by the MAB.

Responsibilities

1. The Group reports to the Military ATM Board (MAB).
2. The Group is responsible for co-ordination and liaison with national military authorities on its work programme.

Authority

The Group shall act at the request of

- the Military ATM Board (MAB);
- the Civil/Military Interface Standing Committee (CMIC), upon a specific MAB Coordination Council (MCC) mandate;
- two or more military representatives of MilHaG;
- the Chairman of the Group.

The Chairman of the Group has the authority to establish task forces as required.

Composition

1. The Chairman shall be a military representative of the Eurocontrol member states, appointed by the MAB for a period of two years.
2. The representatives shall be senior military experts from the Member states.
3. Military representatives of interested non-Member states and organisations may attend as observers.

Support

The EUROCONTROL Agency will provide the necessary support, including secretarial activities.
