DECISION N° 10

relating to the bilateral agreements for the collection of route charges.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION,

Having regard to the "Eurocontrol" International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, and particularly to the provisions of Article 6, para. 2 e) and Articles 12 and 20 thereof;

Having regard to Directives Nos 11 and 14 given to the Agency by the Commission at its XIXth and XXIVth Sessions on 7th December, 1967 and 3rd July, 1969 respectively, relating to the establishment of user charges for route air navigation facilities and services;

Considering that the Governments of the Member States have made known their intention to entrust to the Organisation under bilateral agreements the collection of route charges in respect of the airspace falling within the competence of the said States;

HAS TAKEN THE FOLLOWING DECISION :

Article 1

The draft specimen bilateral agreement relating to the collection of route charges, which was submitted to the Commission at its XXVIIIth Session, is adopted.

Article 2

On the basis of this specimen agreement, the Organisation shall conclude with the Governments of the Member States separate bilateral agreements relating to the collection of route charges.
