DECISION No 20

concerning the conclusion of an association agreement between the Organisation and Spain.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR
NAVIGATION

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation and in particular, to Article 13 thereof;

Having regard to the Association Agreement concluded between the Organisation and Spain on 17 December 1971;

Having regard to the letter of 14 June 1973 in which Spain signified its intention not to renew the said Agreement beyond 31 December 1973;

Having regard to Spain's request that the Agreement of 17 December 1971 be replaced by a new association agreement with a validity of one year as from 1 January 1974, with a view to Spain's accession to the EUROCONTROL Convention.

HAS TAKEN THE FOLLOWING DECISION

Article 1

The Permanent Commission hereby agrees to the conclusion of a new association agreement between the Organisation and Spain as from 1 January 1974 with a validity of one year.

Article 2


The draft agreement submitted to the 40th session of the Permanent Commission is hereby approved.
