DECISION NO. 34

relating to the conclusion of an Agreement between the Organisation and Portugal for the provision of advisory support services.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION

Having regard to the "EUROCONTROL" International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation" signed at Brussels on 13 December 1960;

Having regard to the fact that the Association Agreement with Portugal signed on 26 April 1976 will automatically lapse on the entry into force of the amending Protocol signed on 12 February 1981;

Having regard to the wish of Portugal that continued support and assistance be provided by the Organisation;

Having regard to the draft Agreement relating to the continued provision by EUROCONTROL of advisory services for the modernisation of the ATC system in Portugal, which has been submitted by the Committee of Management;

HAS TAKEN THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Article 1

The Commission approves the draft Agreement with Portugal relating to the provision by EUROCONTROL of advisory services for the modernisation of its ATC system.

Article 2

The Agreement shall enter into force on the same day as the amending Protocol to the EUROCONTROL Convention signed on 13 December 1960.


