DECISION NO. 36

relating to the conclusion of a Special Agreement between the Organisation and the Federal Republic of Germany.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION

Having regard to the "EUROCONTROL" International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation signed in Brussels on 13 December 1960;

Having regard to the need to ensure the continuity of Air Navigation Services at Karlsruhe Air Traffic Control Centre, notwithstanding its transfer to the Federal Republic of Germany on the date of entry into force of the amending Protocol signed on 12 February 1981, pursuant to Article 3 of Annex 3 thereto;

Having regard to the decision by the Federal Republic of Germany setting 1 January 1984 as the target date for the assumption of responsibility of all tasks at the Karlsruhe UAC;

Having regard to the draft Agreement relating to the provision of training by EUROCONTROL to BFS staff at the Karlsruhe UAC which has been submitted to it by the Committee of Management;

HAS TAKEN THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Article 1

The Commission approves the draft Agreement attached hereto with the Federal Republic relating to the provision of training by EUROCONTROL to BFS staff at the Karlsruhe UAC for the period until 31 December 1983.

Article 2

The Agreement shall enter into force with its signature by both parties.


