DIRECTIVE No.04/65

relating to the conclusion by the Agency, on the Organisation's behalf, of agreements which may contribute to the implementation of the uniform European air traffic management system, with public or private services of Member States, of non-Member States which are Members of ECAC, or of International Organisations,

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 6.1(b), 7.3 and 13 thereof;

Having regard to the Protocol consolidating the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, which was opened for signature on 27 June 1997, and in particular Articles 2.1 of the consolidated version of the Convention annexed thereto;

Having regard to Decision No. 71 of 9 December 1997 on early implementation of the revised Convention, in particular in respect of the role and duties of the Organisation;

On the proposal of the Provisional Council and of the Director General,

GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

1. The Agency may conclude, on the Organisation's behalf, agreements which may contribute to the implementation of the uniform European air traffic management system, with public or private services of Member States, of non-Member States which are Members of ECAC, or of International Organisations, in line with the relevant programmes endorsed by the Organisation.
2. Directive No. 82/49 of 13 September 1994 is hereby revoked.
