### DIRECTIVE No. 12/80

#### **relating to the implementation of the User Pays Principle**

The PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 6.1. b) and 7.3 and 13 thereof;

Having regard to Action Paper PC/12//37/14 submitted to the Provisional Council by the Chairman of the Standing Committee on Finance, and in particular recommendation f. thereof;

Whereas the "User Pays Principle" (UPP) scheme may apply for services being provided by the Agency and falling outside the scope of the common budget funding scheme;

On proposal of the Provisional Council,

HEREBY GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

#### Article 1

Services provided by the Agency to Member States and their entities, as identified in the list at Annex, shall be funded from the common budget.

#### Article 2

As a general rule, the principle of full cost recovery shall apply to services not falling within the scope of Article 1:

- as from the date of entry into force of the present Directive, for new agreements for services;
- as from 1 January 2013, for existing agreements for services (through the development of transitional arrangements in the period until 1 January 2015, where appropriate).

Exceptions to this general rule require the prior approval of the Permanent Commission.

**Article 3**


The allocation of indirect costs on the services falling within the scope of Article 2 shall be at the rate set by a Measure of the Permanent Commission.

**Article 4**

This Directive shall enter into effect on 10.5.2012
