DIRECTIVE No 14/85

relating to the conclusion of cooperation arrangements between EUROCONTROL and the European Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GNSS) Agency (GSA)

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation of 13 December 1960, amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 7.3 and 13 thereof;

Having regard to the Protocol consolidating the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation which was opened for signature on 27 June 1997, and in particular Article 2.1 of the consolidated version of the Convention annexed thereto, as provisionally applied under Decision No 71 of the Permanent Commission of 9 December 1997;

Having regard to Decision No 72 of the Permanent Commission of 9 December 1997 on the early implementation of certain provisions of the revised Convention, in particular on the establishment of a Provisional Council;

Having regard to the Agreement between the European Union and EUROCONTROL providing a general framework for enhanced cooperation signed on 20 December 2012 and in particular Article 3.2 f) thereof;


On the proposal of the Director General and the Provisional Council,

GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

The Agency is hereby authorised to conclude, on the Organisation's behalf, cooperation arrangements with the European Global Navigation Satellite Systems (GNSS) Agency (GSA) through the draft exchange of letters at annex.
