DIRECTIVE No. 18/100

Relating to the conclusion of an Agreement with the Commission of the European Union on the provision of the day-to-day management of the EUROCONTROL Sickness Insurance Scheme

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 6.1(b), 7.3 and 13 thereof;

Having regard to article 72 of the Staff Regulations governing officials of the EUROCONTROL Agency and the General Conditions of Employment governing servants at the EUROCONTROL Maastricht Center, and in particular Rule of Application No 10 concerning sickness insurance cover adopted by the Director General;

Having regard to article 73 of the Staff Regulations governing Officials of the EUROCONTROL Agency and the General Conditions of Employment governing servants at the EUROCONTROL Maastricht, concerning insurance against the risk of occupational disease or accidents;

Whereas the day-to-day management of the application of the rules and procedures for the reimbursement of medical expenditure incurred by the beneficiaries of the EUROCONTROL sickness insurance scheme is currently the responsibility of the Settlement Offices created by Rule of Application No 10 adopted by the Director General of the Agency, in particular under article 40 thereof;

Considering that the Agreement with the European Commission would allow the EUROCONTROL Agency to improve the overall functioning of the Sickness Insurance scheme while satisfying its needs for operational efficiency and gains, for the benefit of its beneficiaries;

On the proposal of the Director General and of the Provisional Council,

GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

The Agency is hereby authorised to conclude, on the Organisation's behalf, with the Commission of the European Union, the Agreement required for the provision of the day-to-day management of the EUROCONTROL Sickness Insurance Scheme, in line with the applicable Staff Regulations and the General Conditions of Employment, Rules of Application, and general implementing provisions relating to the reimbursement of medical expenses adopted by the Director General.
