DIRECTIVE N°2

concerning the relations to be established between the Agency, on the one hand, and the "Federal Aviation Agency" and the United States, on the other.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF
AIR NAVIGATION,

Considering the "EUROCONTROL" International Convention relating to co-operation for the safety of air navigation, and, in particular, Article 31 of this Convention;

Considering that in letters dated 29th August and 26th December 1962, the Administrator of the "Federal Aviation Agency" expressed the wish that relations should be established between the EUROCONTROL Organisation, on the one hand, and the "Federal Aviation Agency" and the United States, on the other;

HAS GIVEN THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

It is advisable for the Agency to enter into negotiations with the competent authorities of the United States of America and the "Federal Aviation Agency" with a view to concluding agreements laying down the terms under which exchanges of observes and information could be established.
