DIRECTIVE No 3

relating to the prolongation to the end of 1965 of the 1964
Bilateral Agreements concluded between the Agency and certain
of the States party to the Brussels Convention of 13 December 1960.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION

Having regard to the International Convention relating to the Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation and notably its Article 31;

Considering that it is necessary to continue the transitional period between the present organisation of control services and the final organisation of these services;

Considering that it is desirable that for this transitional period the States should continue to provide the Agency with temporary assistance;

GIVES THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

Article 1

The Agency shall undertake negotiations with the States with which the 1964 Bilateral Agreements have been concluded, with a view to extending the validity of these Agreements to 31 December 1965.
