DIRECTIVE N°5

concerning the relations to be established between the EUROCONTROL Agency and the Office Fédéral de l'Air de la Confédération Helvétique (Switzerland)

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION
FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to co-operation for the safety of Air Navigation and in particular article 31 of this Convention;

Considering that by letter dated 1 July 1964, the Director of the Office Fédéral de l'Air de la Confédération Helvétique expressed the wish that relations be established between the EUROCONTROL Organisation and the Office Fédéral de l'Air de la Confédération Helvétique;

Considering that the Swiss authorities have agreed to these relations being founded on the same principles as those on which is based the co-operation between Eurocontrol and the Scandinavian countries;

HAS GIVEN THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY:

Sole Article

It is desirable for the Agency to negotiate with the competent authorities of the Swiss Confederation for the purpose of laying down the conditions in which relations could be established between the Agency and the Office Fédéral de l'Air de la Confédération Helvétique.
