DIRECTIVE No.7

relating to the conclusion between the Agency and certain signatory States to the Convention of 13th December 1960, of Bilateral Agreements concerning the air traffic services in the upper airspace, from 1st January 1966.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION

Having regard to the International Convention for co-operation for the safety of air navigation and in particular Article 31 of this Convention;

Having regard to the Decision of 7th October 1963 determining the configuration of the upper airspace for which the air traffic services are entrusted to the Agency, amended by the Decision of 21st December 1965;

GIVES THE AGENCY THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE :

Article One


The Agency is commissioned to conclude, with the signatory States to the Bilateral Agreements at present in force, agreements extending the validity of these Agreements to 31st December 1966, taking into consideration with regard to the Federal Republic of Germany, the Decision of 21st December 1965, modifying the configuration of its upper airspace.

Article Two

A special clause provides for the termination of the agreement with a view to substitution of a new agreement resulting from a decision which the Permanent Commission is expected to take following the proposals formulated by the Working Group of Directors General.
