DIRECTIVE No. 9

concerning the relations to be established between the Eurocontrol Agency and the Portuguese General Directorate of Civil Aviation.

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION

Having regard to the "Eurocontrol" International Convention relating to co-operation for the safety of air navigation and in particular Article 31 thereof;

Considering that in a letter dated 26th February 1966, the Director General of Civil Aviation in Portugal expressed the wish to establish relations between the Eurocontrol Organization and the Portuguese General Directorate of Civil Aviation;

Considering that the Portuguese authorities agree that these relations should be established on the same principles as those governing the co-operation between Eurocontrol and the Scandinavian countries;

HAS GIVEN THE FOLLOWING DIRECTIVE TO THE AGENCY :

Sole Article

It is desirable that the Agency should conclude an agreement with the competent Portuguese authorities defining the conditions under which a relationship may be established between the Agency and the General Directorate of Civil Aviation in Portugal.
