**DECISION N° 40**

**amending the Rules of Procedure of the enlarged Commission**

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION, ENLARGED TO INCLUDE REPRESENTATIVES OF NON-MEMBER STATES:

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, amended by the Protocol signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular its Articles 2.1 (l) and 5.2;

Having regard to the Multilateral Agreement relating to Route Charges signed at Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular its Article 3.3;

Having regard to the Protocol consolidating the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, which was opened for signature on 27 June 1997, and in particular the consolidated version of the Convention annexed thereto, hereinafter referred to as "the revised Convention";


Having regard to the resolution on early implementation of the Protocol, unanimously adopted at the Conference of Plenipotentiaries on 27 June 1997, urging all Contracting Parties to participate, to the fullest extent possible, in the realisation of the early implementation of certain provisions in the revised Convention;

Considering the desirability of an early implementation, where appropriate, of certain provisions of the revised Convention and the need to amend for that purpose, inter alia, the Rules of Procedure of the enlarged Commission;

HEREBY TAKES THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

With effect from 1 January 1998, the Rules of Procedure of the enlarged Commission which are at present in force shall be replaced by the provisions annexed hereto, subject to the approval of the amendments to the Rules of Procedure of the Permanent Commission under Item 9 of the agenda of the 85th Session of the Permanent Commission.
