**concerning the appointment of an alternate member of the EUROCONTROL Pension Fund Supervisory Board**

THE PERMANENT COMMISSION FOR THE SAFETY OF AIR NAVIGATION,

Having regard to the EUROCONTROL International Convention relating to Co-operation for the Safety of Air Navigation, as amended by the Protocol signed in Brussels on 12 February 1981, and in particular Articles 6.1b) and 7.3 thereof;

Having regard to the Appendix to the Statute of the Agency (Regulations of the EUROCONTROL Pension Fund), in particular Articles 5.1 and 5.2 thereof;

Having regard to Measure of the Permanent Commission No 12/184 of 24.8.12, concerning the appointment of the members of the EUROCONTROL Pension Fund Supervisory Board, in particular Article 4.2 thereof;

Having regard to Measure of the Permanent Commission No 13/189 of 8.5.13, concerning the appointment of a member of the EUROCONTROL Pension Fund Supervisory Board, in particular Article 1.1 thereof;

Having regard to Measure of the Permanent Commission No 13/191 of 25.6.13, concerning the appointment of an alternate member of the EUROCONTROL Pension Fund Supervisory Board, in particular Article 1.1 thereof;

Having regard to the proposal submitted by the Central Staff Committee for the appointment of a person to carry out the duties of representative of the staff on the Supervisory Board;

on a proposal from the Provisional Council,

HEREBY TAKES THE FOLLOWING MEASURE:

**Article 1**

1. Mr Steve Mention shall be appointed as an alternate member of the Supervisory Board representing the EUROCONTROL staff, as a replacement for Mr Kristiaan Van De Velde.
2. This appointment shall be for the period remaining until the end of the latter's term of office, i.e. until 31 August 2014.

**Article 2**
